

Our first lesson was on "The Birth of Jesus." One multiple choice question in the material read this way: When was Jesus born? (Matt. 2:1) a. On Christmas Day, b. In the days of Herod the King, or c. On December the twenty-fifth? The biblical answer is b. In the days of Herod the King. I then shared the following truths about the origin of Christmas. "December 25th began to be celebrated as Christmas, the birthday of Jesus in 354 AD, as ordered by Bishop Liberius of Rome." (The World Book Encyclopedia, Vol. C, #3, p. 416). The catholic church was not fully developed at that time—the first pope came in 606 AD; apostasy was moving in that direction. Why did Liberius choose December 25 to celebrate the birth of Jesus? In 312 AD Constantine had a "vision" at Milvian Bridge. In 313 AD, Constantine made "Christianity" the state religion of Rome. Masses of pagans like Constantine were converted to "Christianity." They had celebrated the Mithraic Feast of the Sun God at that time of the year. As days got shorter, they thought their god was losing his strength. Gradually, the days got longer. This pagan festival celebrated the triumph of light over darkness. When they learned of Christ, he became their "new light" so Liberius set December 25 to celebrate the birth of Jesus in an effort to turn away attention from these pagan feasts.

LEGISLATIVE ALERT — GAMBLING Jim E. Waldron

The New Year will see many bills to promote the lottery and other forms of gambling put forward in the legislative assemblies of this nation. Gambling is a very big tree that grows out of the soil of covetousness and "covetousness is idolatry" (Col. 3:5). While for generations states fought the "numbers racket" because it was a plague on society and its economic health, they are now promoting such.

Robert Goodman of Northampton, Massachusetts published a book on gambling in 1995 in which he carefully documented many of the evils of the gambling explosion in America. Here are three brief statements from that book:

- "Yet criminals never promoted their gambling operations the way governments now do with multi-million dollar advertising campaigns, public relations efforts, focus group research, and penetration studies. No matter what you do for a living," says a Massachusetts Lottery advertisement, "there's an easier way to make money" p. 136.
- When Thomas J. Meskill ran for governor of Connecticut in the early 1970s, he promised voters that if they elected him, he would work hard to have a new state lottery so that they wouldn't have to introduce a state income tax. Meskill got elected and Connecticut not only got a lottery but also went on to legalize betting on horses, dogs, and jai alai to avoid imposing an income tax. Twenty years later, the state found itself with a higher per capita amount being spent on legal gambling than almost any other state in the country, as well as with the highest recorded incidence of problem gambling -- over 6 percent of the state's adult population." p 157.
- "It is quite possible that at no other time in history have so many people been trying so hard to make money without having to work for it" p. 188.

Let me urge you to phone and/or write your member of the state legislature and urge him or her to oppose the growth of gambling in your state. Better yet, buy a copy of the above named book and put it into the hands of your representative. SODOMITES

The Holy Spirit testified in I Corinthians, "Do you not know the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God?
